- 21** **Cleaning**

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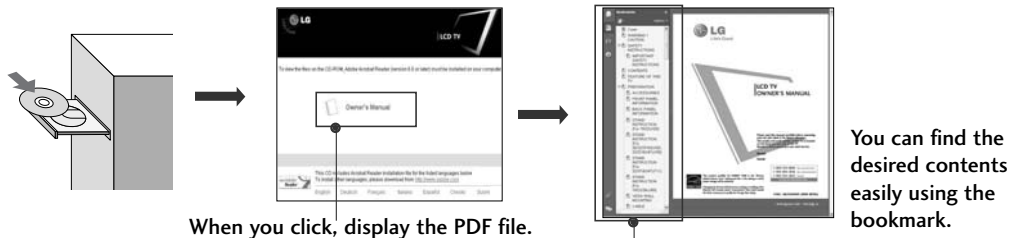
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HOW TO USE THE OWNER'S MANUAL ON THE CD-ROM

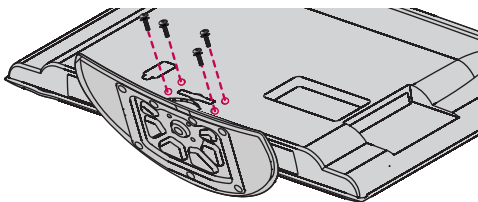
- 1 Carefully place the TV screen side down on a cushioned surface to protect the screen from damage.

- 3 Fix the 4 screws securely using the holes in the back of the TV.

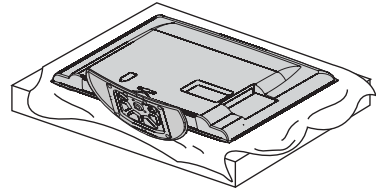





VESA WALL MOUNTING

Install your wall mount on a solid wall perpendicular to the floor. When attaching to other building materials, please contact your nearest installer.

If installed on a ceiling or slanted wall, it may fall and result in severe personal injury.

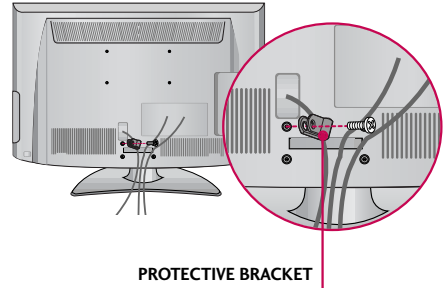

CABLE MANAGEMENT

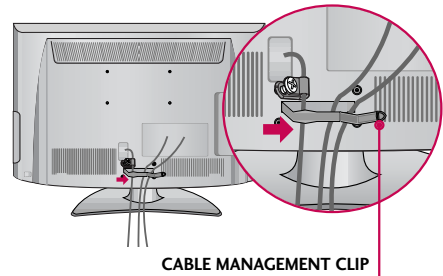

Secure the power cable with the **PROTECTIVE BRACKET** and **SCREW** as shown. It will help prevent the power cable from being removed by accident.



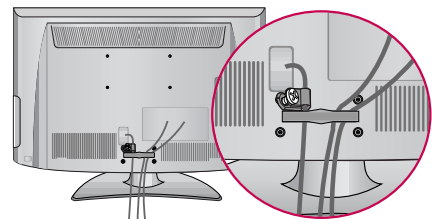
- 2 Install the **CABLE MANAGEMENT CLIP** as shown.

Sorry, A phono Jack to stereo 1/8" (0.32 cm) headphone plug adapter is not included. It is available from most stores that carry electronics.

4 Composite



Use Composite for the video connection if available. Match the jack colors.

You can use an adapter to connect DVI to HDMI, but you will only have 2 channel stereo for sound. The adapter is not needed when connecting a PC.

Antenna/Cable

Use this connection when you need to connect directly to an antenna or cable system instead of using a cable box.

TURNING ON TV

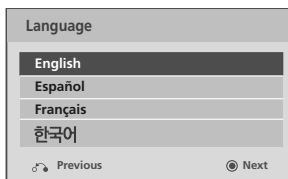
- 1 First, connect power cord correctly.
At this moment, the TV switches to standby mode.
 - In standby mode to turn TV on, press the ϕ /I, **INPUT, CH** (\blacktriangle or \blacktriangledown) button on the TV or press the **POWER, INPUT, CH** (\wedge or \vee), **Number (0-9)** button on the remote control.
- 2 Select the viewing source by using the **INPUT** button on the remote control.
 - This TV is programmed to remember which power state it was last set to, even if the power cord is out.
- 3 When finished using the TV, press the **POWER** button on the remote control. The TV reverts to standby mode.

INITIAL SETTING

This Function guides the user to easily set the essential items for viewing the TV for the first time when purchasing the TV. It will be displayed on the screen when turning the TV on for the first time. It can also be activated from the user menus.

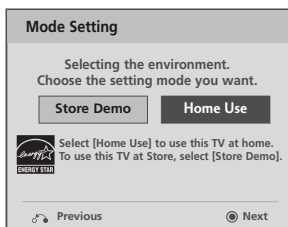
- Default selection is “**Home Use**”. We recommend setting the TV to “**Home Use**” mode for the best picture in your home environment.
- “**Store Demo**” Mode is only intended for use in retail environments. Customers can adjust the “**Picture** menu - **Picture mode**” manually while inspecting the TV, but the TV will automatically return to preset in-store mode after 5 minutes.
- “**Store Demo**” Mode is an optimal setting for displaying at stores. “Store Demo” mode initializes the TV to set the image quality.
- You can also adjust **Initial Setting** in the **OPTION** menu.



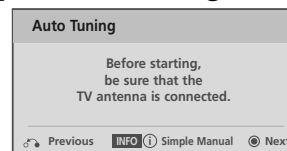

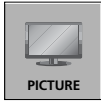
WATCHING TV

ON-SCREEN MENUS SELECTION

Your TV's OSD (On Screen Display) may differ slightly from that shown in this manual.
(Some of these features are not available on all models.)



- Auto Tuning: All available TV channels are searched and stored automatically.
- Manual Tuning: User can do manual channel selection and add or delete individual channels.
- Channel Edit: You can add or delete in the channel list.



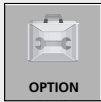
- Aspect Ratio: Selects the desired picture format.
- Picture Wizard: This feature lets you adjust the picture quality of the original image.
- Energy Saving: It reduces the TV's power consumption by lowering the backlight level.
- Picture Mode: Selects a picture mode that is best suited for the program you are currently watching.
- Screen (RGB-PC): Adjust the screen Resolution, Auto config, Position, Size, Phase, Reset.



- Auto Volume: Auto Volume makes sure that the volume level remains consistent whether you are watching a commercial or a regular TV program.
- Clear Voice II: By differentiating the human sound range from others, it helps users listen to human voices better.
- Balance: Adjust the left/right sound of speaker.
- Sound Mode: Select the sound mode to Standard, Music, Cinema, Sport, and Game.
- TV Speaker: Turn the TV speakers off if using external audio equipment.
- External Speaker: Turn the external speakers on if using external audio equipment.



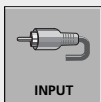
- Clock: Set the current time Auto or Manual.
- Off Time: Set the time the TV will automatically be turned off.
- OnTime: Set the time the TV will automatically be turned on.
- Sleep Timer: Select the amount of time before your TV turns off automatically:



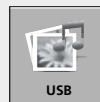
- Menu Language: The menus can be shown on the screen in the selected language.
- Audio Language: Selects your desired language in the digital broadcasting.
- Input Label: Sets a label to each input source.
- SIMPLINK: Control devices connected via HDMI.
- Key Lock: This feature can be used to prevent unauthorized viewing by locking out the front panel controls.
- Caption: Selects and displays a caption. Captions are provided to help people with hearing loss watch TV.
- Set ID: Choose the desired TV ID number.
- Power Indicator: Adjust the power/standby indicator light of TV front.
- Demo Mode: Displays a slide show to explain the various feature of this TV.
- Initial Setting: Select either Store Demo or Home Use.



- Lock System: Select On or Off.
- Set Password: Change the password.
- Block Channel: Select a channel number that you wish to block.
- Movie Rating: Blocks movies according to the movie ratings limits specified.
- TV Rating-Children: Prevents children from watching certain children's TV programs, according to the ratings limit set.
- TV Rating-General: Based on the ratings, blocks certain TV programs that you and your family do not want to view.
- Downloadable Rating: This function is available only for digital channel signal.
- Input Block: Enables you to select a source to block from the external source devices you have hooked up.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Abnormal Operation	
The remote control doesn't work	<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Check to see if there is any object between the product and the remote control causing obstruction. Ensure you are pointing the remote control directly at the TV.■ Ensure that the batteries are installed with correct polarity (+ to +, - to -).■ Ensure that the correct remote operating mode is set: TV, VCR etc.■ Install new batteries. <p style="text-align: right;">*This feature is not available for all models.</p>
Power is suddenly turned off	<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Is the sleep timer set?■ Check the power control settings. Power interrupted.■ If there is no signal, the TV turns off automatically in 15 minutes.

Video Problems	
No picture & No sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Check whether the product is turned on.■ Try another channel. The problem may be with the broadcast.■ Is the power cord inserted into wall power outlet?■ Check your antenna direction and/or location.■ Test the wall power outlet, plug another product's power cord into the outlet where the product's power cord was plugged in.
Picture appears slowly after switching on	<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ This is normal, the image is muted during the product startup process. Please contact your service center, if the picture has not appeared after five minutes.
No or poor color or poor picture	<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Adjust Color in menu option.■ Keep a sufficient distance between the product and the VCR.■ Try another channel. The problem may be with the broadcast.■ Are the video cables installed properly?■ Activate any function to restore the brightness of the picture.
Horizontal/vertical bars or picture shaking	<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Check for local interference such as an electrical appliance or power tool.
Poor reception on some channels	<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Station or cable product experiencing problems, tune to another station.■ Station signal is weak, reorient antenna to receive weaker station.■ Check for sources of possible interference.
Lines or streaks in pictures	<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Check antenna (Change the direction of the antenna).
No picture when connecting HDMI	<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Check HDMI cable over version 1.3. The HDMI cables don't support HDMI version 1.3, it cause flickers or no screen display. In this case use the latest cables that support HDMI version 1.3.

Audio Problems

Picture OK & No sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Press the VOL or VOLUME button.■ Sound muted? Press MUTE button.■ Try another channel. The problem may be with the broadcast.■ Are the audio cables installed properly?
No output from one of the speakers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Adjust Balance in menu option.

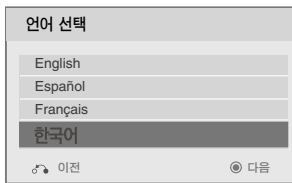

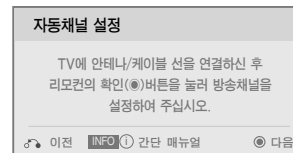

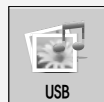
