

Quick start quide

In multihandset packs, you will find one or more additional handsets, chargers with power adapter units, additional rechargeable battery packs and battery doors.

User's quide

IMPORTANT


Only use the telephone line cord supplied.

Power adapter

This equipment is not designed for making emergency telephone calls when the power fails. Alternative arrangements should be made for access to emergency services.

1 Getting started

Step 1. Connect the base



- Plug the power adapter with smaller pin plug & telephone line cord into the base. Power adapter with bigger pin plug is for charger (for multi-pack only).
- Plug the other end of the power adapter & telephone line cord into the wall jack.


TIPS

Do not place your phone in the bathroom or other humid areas. Please refer to the user's guide for more cautions when you choose the location of your phone.

IMPORTANT

Only use the power adapter and telephone line cord supplied with the product.

Step 2. Install and charge the handset battery pack



- Slide out the battery compartment cover. Place the supplied rechargeable battery pack in the battery compartment, with the battery connector plugged in, as shown.
- Slide the battery compartment cover back.
- Put the handset on the base to charge for at least 24 hours. When the handset is fully charged the will indicate that it is fully charged.

IMPORTANT

Use only the rechargeable battery pack provided.

Step 3. Set the display language

- Press and to select SETUP HS.

- Press and to select the language.
- Press state to save.

Step 4. Set date and time

- Press to select DATE & TIME.
- Press and edit the year and date.

TIPS

You can press ito move between the input fields YEAR and DATE.

- Press and edit the time in 12hr format. Press to toggle AM/
 PM settings.
- Press to save the settings.

NOTE

If you have subscribed to your network's Caller ID service, the date and time is set automatically for all handsets every time a call is received.

Step 5. Your phone is now ready for use.

Using the phone



Make a call

Enter the phone number and press or to dial the phone number

Dialing a number from memory

When you get a dial tone by pressing or or press the M1/ M2 / M3 to dial the priority number.

Storing a number in memory

- Dial the number to be stored at idle state.
- Press and hold specific memory location buttons M1/M2/M3
- Press the SELECT button

Answer a call

When the phone rings and \ flashes in the display, press or press to answer the call

End a call

During a call, press or put the handset on the base cradle.

Adjust volume

During a call, press (to adjust the speaker volume or press - + to adjust the earpiece volume.

Turn on or off the audio boost

During a call, press AUDIO BOOST to turn on or off the audio boost. LED on the top of handset will be lit when audio boost on.

Dial from the redial list

- Press and then to the entry you want to redial.
- Press or to dial the number.

Dial from the calls list

- Press and then to the entry you want to dial.
- Press or to dial the number.

Add entry to phonebook

- Press and press to select ADD.
- Press and enter the name.
 Press and enter the number.
- Press and to select a melody.
- Press to save settings.

Dial from the phonebook

- Press then scroll to select the entry you want to dial.
- Press or to dial the number.

NOTE

Phonebook entries, calls list, redial list and numbers stored in the memory will remain unchanged

Paging/Find handset

Press (FIND) on the base. All handsets registered to the base will ring.

• To stop the paging, press FIND again, or press 1 on the handset, or place the handset on the cradle.

The icon is not scrolling when the handset is placed on the base

- · Bad battery contact move the handset slightly
- Dirty contact clean the battery contact with a cloth moistened with alcohol
- Battery is full no need to charge

No dial tone

- No base power check the connections. Reset the phone: unplug and plug back in the electrical outlet.
- Handset batteries are empty charge the battery pack for at least 24 hours.
- Handset may be too far from the base move closer to the base.
- Wrong telephone line cord use the telephone line cord provided.

Poor audio quality

 The base is too close to electrical appliances, reinforced concrete walls or metal doorframes - move the base away from any electrical appliances.

No ring tone

- The ring tone is deactivated.
- Increase the volume.

Caller ID does not work

· Check your subscription with your network operator.

A phonebook entry cannot be stored

· The phonebook is full. Delete an entry to free memory.

No display

- Try recharging or replacing the battery pack.
- Reset the base. Unplug the unit's electrical power, then plug it back in.
- If LED is not lit up, then try to unplug the unit's electrical power, then plug it back in.

When the handset lost its link with the base during a call

- Check the power cord is connected properly into the base.
- · Check the power adapter is connected properly into an electrical outlet.
- Move the handset closer to the base. It may be out of range.
- Reset the base by unplugging the unit's electrical power. Wait for around 15 seconds and plug it back in again. Allow up to one minute for the handset and the base to synchronize.

Noise interference on your radio or television

· Your base or charger may be too close. Move it as far away as possible.
