

How to Measure for Your New Dishwasher



This checklist will guide you through the process of measuring the space for your **new dishwasher**, and assist in verifying all of the technical aspects related to electric and water hookup. It will also help ensure that our installers allocate enough time to perform the installation.

Measuring Your Home:

Measure the height of the space from the floor in front of the dishwasher to the underside of the countertop. Has a new floor been installed since the installation of the current dishwasher? This may complicate the removal of the old dishwasher.

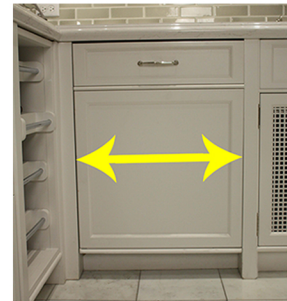
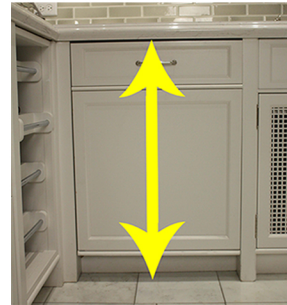
What material are the countertops made of: made of?

If there is no dishwasher currently installed, measure the height of the space on both sides, in the front and the back. Also, Measure the depth of the space including any trim, electrical boxes or pipes, which may be in the way of the new installation.

Does your existing dishwasher have a custom panel? If so, it probably will fit your replacement dishwasher. If not, our in-house woodshop may be able to modify it or fabricate a new one.

To find out if your panel will fit, send a photo and model number to your salesperson.
