

How to Measure for Your New Appliances



One of the most important parts of shopping for new **home appliances** is making sure you've got proper measurements for the area where it will be installed. This guide will help make sure that your appliance delivery goes as smoothly as possible.

Measuring Your Home:

In addition to measuring the spot where the appliances will be going, it's important to measure the entire path the appliance will take when it's delivered, starting at the front door.

Measure the width of your front door opening. With your permission, our installers can remove doors from their hinges, if needed.

Measure all doorways and hallways the appliance will be passing through. Be sure to account for any decorative trim, light fixtures or anything else that sticks out from the walls or ceiling that might get in the way.

If the appliance is going up or down stairs, measure the width and height of the stairway, and remember to include the handrails. If there's a turn in the stairs, make sure to measure its narrowest point.
